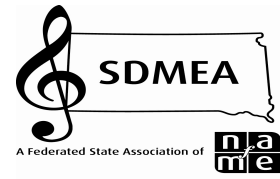


MSASB Flute Scales

Chromatic Scale

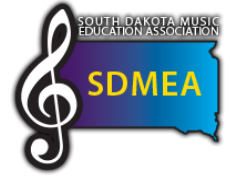
