This year marks the 20<sup>th</sup> Annual South Dakota Music Educators Association Middle School All-State Band. The past nineteen years have presented the opportunity to grow in our service to young musicians across the state. SDMEA takes great pride in this event as a way to provide an opportunity for students who thrive on challenge and expertise. To celebrate our 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary, our guest conductor is composer Tyler S. Grant!!

### Eligibility Requirements

1. Students in grades 6-8 who are currently enrolled in a South Dakota public or private school band program are eligible to audition. Audition recordings must be submitted by the band director or the student's private lesson instructor. (Band Director/Private Instructor MUST be a current member of SDMEA)
2. Selected participants are required to be in attendance for ALL rehearsals of Middle School All-State Band. Please check your calendars to avoid conflicts. **In most cases, no alternates will be placed for those students that are selected and choose not to attend the event.**

### Audition Requirements

1. All auditions will be submitted online. We will use Music Festival Software Solutions to upload auditions. You will be sent an email with directions on how to access the audition site. You will also be asked for a username & password, those will also be sent in an email.
2. Each scale & etude will be uploaded *individually*, **in Mp3 format only**, in the following order:
  - a. Winds: chromatic, major, minor, 6/8, 4/4 (5 recordings to upload)
  - b. Percussion: Major scale, minor scale, mallet etude, timpani etude, rudiment 1, rudiment 2, snare etude (7 recordings to upload)
3. The scales and etudes should be played as written.
4. Please do not have the students identify themselves when recording.

### Audition Information

1. **Audition deadline is December 7<sup>th</sup>, 2018**  
*The ability to upload audition material to the website will be unavailable after 11:59 PM CDT on December 7<sup>th</sup>, 2018. This will allow for a prompt adjudication, with notification to the director's email by January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2019 and on the SDMEA website soon after.*
2. There is a \$9 audition fee (per audition). Audition fees may be paid by credit card on the Music Festival Software Solutions website or by **sending a check to Andrea Harstad**. (please do NOT send cash)
  - a. **Checks need to be made payable to SDMEA, BUT send to Andrea.** (ONE check per school)
  - b. Please print the summary of auditions page and send it with the check.
  - c. Checks need to be postmarked by **December 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018**
  - d. **Please note:** you will be charged for all auditions complete and incomplete if you have uploaded audition materials. NO refunds will be issued for incomplete auditions.
3. There will be an *additional* registration fee of \$9 per student selected to the festival or honor band. That registration fee will be due **February 8<sup>th</sup>, 2019**.
4. **Submitted auditions that do not meet the eligibility and/or audition requirements will not be adjudicated.**
